

Creating your virtual poster

Virtual poster technical requirements

- The Virtual Poster must be one page. Additional pages will not be accepted.
- The width is 33.1 inches (841 mm); the maximum height is 46.8 inches (1189 mm).
- The file size may **not exceed 10MB**
- All files must be saved and submitted **as a PDF and JPG**

Virtual poster design requirements

- Font size: 28pt or larger.
- Recommended fonts: Georgia, Times New Roman, Helvetica, or Arial. It's possible that other fonts may have cross-operating system display issues. Letters should be easily read (avoid Old English and other "fancy" fonts).
- Avoid background images and watermarks that may detract from the readability of your poster.

Important information to include on your poster

Depending on study design/preference, not all points below [except for those marked in **bold**] have to be included on the poster.

- Title and Author Information:
 - **Title**
 - Subtitle
 - **Author, Affiliation, City, Country** (repeat for each author)
 - University/Affiliate Logos
- Content:
 - **Abstract/Short Description (including Relevance)**
 - Introduction/Long Description/Background/Relevance
 - **Research Question/Hypothesis**
 - **Methods**
 - Results
 - **Conclusion/Summary**
 - References
 - **Images**
